Located in the Ntlangano Community Reserve in the Eastern Cape the site proposed for the new lodge is dramatically perched on the edge of a cliff overlooking the spectacular Tsitsa Falls. The first phase of the lodge accommodation comprised a 400m² 'bhoma' with lounge, bar, kitchen and dining to seat 30 guests. An outdoor terrace is cantilevered over the gorge to provide uninterrupted views of the waterfall. This phase also included 12 x 2-bed chalets set among the rocky north-facing slopes behind the bhoma.

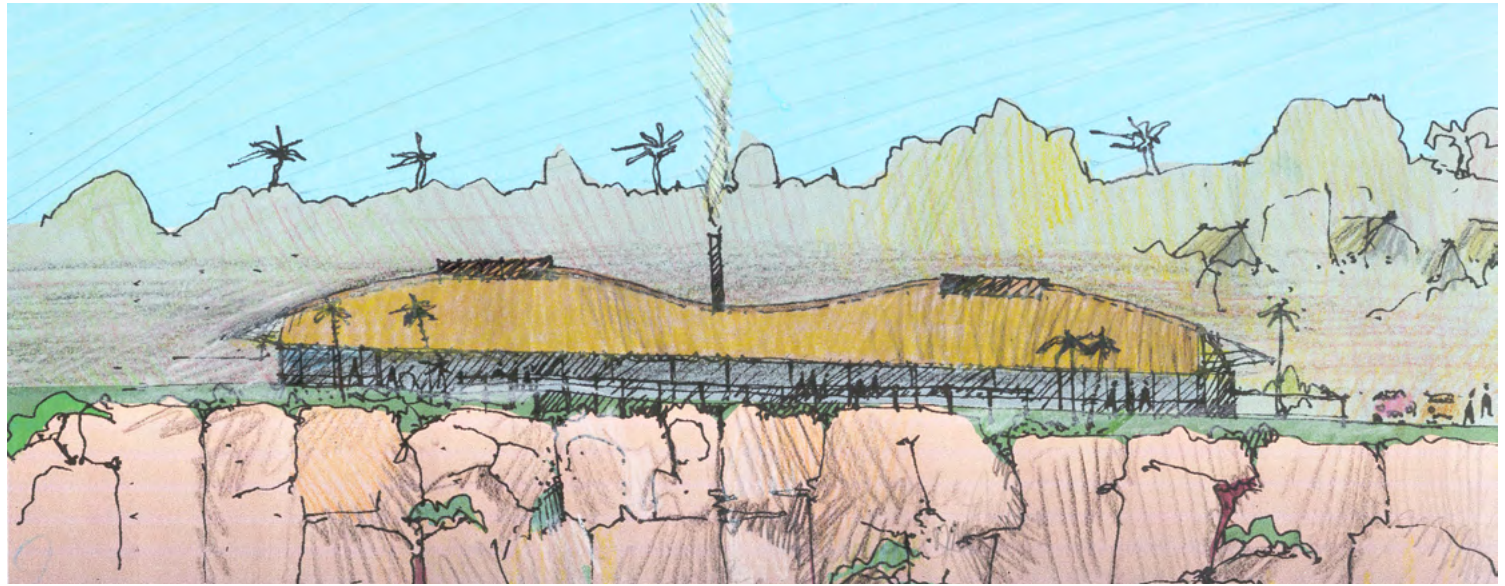
